DRESSAGE CLASSES: MEMBER: \$25.00 per class NON-MEMBER: \$30.00 per class

NON-COMPETING HORSE FEE: \$35.00 per horse. Horses not competing but on the show grounds must be entered as a non-competing horse and have a number. Non-competing horse fee includes office and the grounds/haul-in fee. Stabling/stalls is an extra fee.
